Woodward County Farm Bureau has a Scholarship Program for graduating Seniors. It will be a \$1500 scholarship divided into four (4) years, \$250.00 for each of the first and second years, then \$500.00 for each of the third and fourth years, as long as the student remains in an agriculture or Ag related field of study.

The applicant's parents, or the applicant themselves, must be a member of Woodward County Farm Bureau, to qualify. Farm Bureau is an Agricultural organization, therefore, the applicant needs to be pursuing an agriculture related field or Agri-Business. Each applicant, if chosen to receive a scholarship, will be asked to provide Woodward County Farm Bureau with an enrollment form or class schedule as proof of continuing in Ag-related field at the start of the Fall semester. This is a requirement in order to receive the next payment.
